INSTRUCTIONS FOR I MBBS (2020-21 Batch) STUDENTS

1)	Every student should install the "Aarogya Setu" app in their smart phone. Students should attend the college with the report for COVID-19 RT PCR test done not before 72 hours of college/hostel attending.
2)	For day-scholars, the college buses will be provided from Vijayawada and Guntur with proper safety precautions against COVID-19.
3)	Both Boys' and girls' hostels are open with all safety precautions and they are ready to be occupy. Students should maintain proper hygiene in their hostel rooms and they should not allow other hostel-mates in to their rooms. During their breakfast/Lunch/Dinner inside the hostel mess, they should sit by maintaining physical distance and absolute silence. Hostellers will not be allowed to move outside the college premises under any circumstances.
4)	All the students should enter into the college through "Triage" which are present in the main entrance of college (College Portico).
5)	At the Triage, students should maintain social distance and have their temperature checked before entering into their respective departments.
6)	Each student should wear face mask and should bring their own hand sanitizer, water bottles and snacks (College cafeteria will be closed).
7)	Students should be observed the following instructions in the Practical Halls to prevent the COVID-19 infections. a) Physical distancing of at least 6 feet between persons. b) Mandatory use of face covers / masks. c) Frequent use of alcohol based hand sanitizers. d) Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue / hand kerchief / flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly. e) Sharing of items like notebook, pens/pencil, eraser, water bottle etc., amongst students will not be allowed. f) Students are strictly instructed not to gather in groups at any time in the college premises.
8)	Day scholars should have their lunch in the designated area i.e., Exam hall 3, second floor (above Mini Auditorium) by maintaining physical distance.
9)	Self-monitoring of health by all and report of any illness at the earliest.
10)	Spitting shall be strictly prohibited inside the college / hospital premises.
11)	Disciplinary action will be taken if any student is found violating the above safety instructions.
